### Mission

**Children's Scholarship Fund (CSF):** provides children of low-income families with tuition assistance in grades K-8, and supports expanding educational opportunities for all children.

**Young Leaders Board:** Founded in 2012, the CSF Young Leaders (YL) Board is a network of young professionals that supports CSF's mission and seeks to maximize educational opportunities for New York City children.

### What the Young Leaders Board Does

The Young Leaders Board assists in fundraising, volunteering, and raising awareness about CSF among their friend, families and colleagues.

Board members are expected to:

- **Contribute \$250** each year for CSF scholarships.
- **Volunteer** for Young Leaders Board sponsored learning and mentoring activities with CSF Scholars and alumni.
- **Participate** in quarterly Young Leaders Board meetings and support fundraising events.
- **Raise awareness** about CSF by encouraging friends and colleagues to attend CSF events, support peer-to-peer fundraising campaigns, and become engaged with the Young Leaders Board, as well as by helping to identify opportunities for corporate partnerships and sponsorships.

### Young Leaders Board Structure

- Volunteer-based membership with 50-60 members and 4 committees
- Goal: fund 20+ scholarships annually

**Social Governance:** Responsible for assisting with Membership recruitment and retention. Welcome new members to the Young Leaders Board; plan non-fundraising social events, happy hours and networking opportunities to connect Young Leaders and build community; propose ideas and topics that can help inform Young Leaders about education issues and board-related skills such as fundraising, including Lunch and Learn or Cocktails and Conversation type events with invited speakers.

**Events & Fundraising:** Responsible for generating ideas for fundraising activities and events and implementing them, driving the discussion and mobilizing the participation of the full Young Leaders Board. Fundraising activities over the years have included an annual Party for a Purpose, sponsoring a team of runners in the NYC Full Marathon and Half Marathon, Giving Tuesday outreach, Trivia Nights, Spin or Fitness events, events at members' workplaces, and DIY fundraisers planned by YL Board members.

**Volunteer & Mentorship:** Responsible for working with CSF to organize opportunities to volunteer to help CSF Scholars and partner schools with done-in-a-day type projects. In the past, these have included speaking at career day or college night events, organizing literacy and after school activities at schools, sharing college and career advice, including resume building and networking skills, school improvement projects such as painting, fulfilling Holiday or back to school wish lists, and similar opportunities.

**Marketing & Partnerships:** Responsible for working with CSF to raise awareness about the organization with Young Leaders Board members' employers and friends, as appropriate. This can include reminding members about corporate giving, matching grants, and volunteer grant opportunities; helping to introduce CSF staff to corporate philanthropy and social responsibility departments; assisting in sharing CSF social media and linked in information more broadly to raise awareness of CSF and the Young Leaders Board, and other activities.
