What are Education Freedom Accounts?

Education Freedom Accounts (EFA) are grants from the State of New Hampshire, administered by CSF, made available to families with incomes at or below 350% of the poverty level to spend on their children's education, including tuition at the school of their choice, tutoring, classes, online learning programs, educational supplies, technology, and other educational expenses.



Am I eligible for an Education Freedom Account (EFA)?

To be eligible:

- 1 You must be a New Hampshire resident.
- 2 Your child must be at least 5 years old and entering K-12th grade.
- 3 Students who will attend their local district public or a charter school full-time in school year 2025-26 will not be eligible to receive an EFA.
- 4 Your family's income must be at or below 350% of the poverty guidelines shown in the chart below.

350% 2025 Federal Poverty Level Guidelines

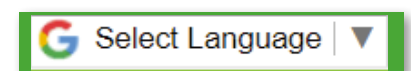


- 5 You must complete the application process and sign the EFA agreement, which includes agreeing to share academic accountability documents.
